The Barbican Library is pleased to present an exhibition of the artist Julie Brixey-Williams. This varied body of work explores the two-way relationship that the body shares with space and brings together a varied selection of works such as collage, photography, video, performance and drawing that aim to expose the traces and choreographic hieroglyphs we create as we move through the world.

Her collaborations with dancers are well known and a selection of the pirouette drawings from the limited-edition book *locationotation* will be on show alongside the larger performance-based *Arabesque* (originally commissioned for the Victoria and Albert Museum and performed by Karen Mok and Patricia Woltmann) plus paintings and images dealing with actuality and continuity in movement.

Julie is a founder member of *point and place*, a group of six artists researching collaborative process, which culminated in 2008 in the award-winning book "point and place", and recently, set up *Species of Spaces*, a group for dialogue and active experimentation for artists working on the potent edges of visual and live art.

During the duration of the exhibition she will be working within the library to create a site-based calligraphic work based on gestures and language.
